Elie Lazar, is currently in his 1st season as Artistic Director of Montgomery Ballet. Born in Israel, Mr. Lazar began his ballet training at age 17 with the Israel National Ballet Company. This led to appearances with the Israel National Opera, the Haifa Ballet and the Inbar Dance Company. In 2000, Mr. Lazar founded and directed the Joffrey Ensemble Dancers, the performance group associated with the Joffrey Ballet School in New York City. In addition to his acclaim as a dancer, Mr. Lazar is building a reputation as a versatile and inventive choreographer. Mr. Lazar is also the director of Lazar Ballet NYC. Based in NYC, the company tours extensively and holds residencies throughout the country during the summer months.

Meryane Martin Murphy, born in Tennessee, studied and performed with the Nashville Ballet and spent her summers at professional training programs in the United States and Canada. Among her teachers were Mme. Hilda Butsova, George Zoritch, Mme. Felia Doubrovskaya, Vera Volkova, Robert Joffrey, Arnold Spohr, and Mira Popovich. Ms. Murphy holds a BA in Dance from Birmingham Southern College and continued her education with graduate work in dance at NYU. Since moving to Andalusia in 1979, she has operated the Andalusia Academy of Ballet and served as Artistic Director of Andalusia Ballet.

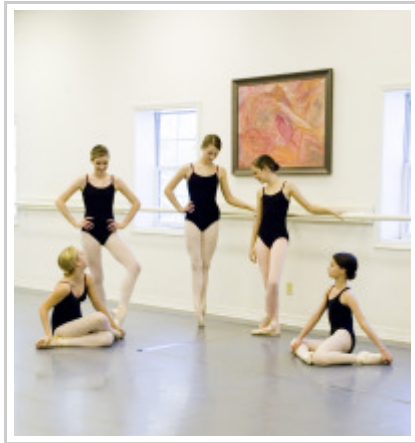

As an essential part of the dancer's training process, Andalusia Ballet offers exceptional summer study programs and the opportunity for upper level students to perform with professional dancers. This opportunity to train with our wonderful faculty and guest Master Teacher, Elie Lazar, through intensive daytime classes is an important part of any dancers continued training.

Our Intensive Summer Program instills a carefully designed curriculum of daily classes for qualified students. The Andalusia Ballet Summer Intensive is a two-week program of intensive ballet training geared toward dancers who demonstrate a high level of achievement, potential, and **most importantly**, a love for dance. Dancers will notice a marked improvement as they enjoy extended daily technique, pointe and yoga classes. Our summer students dance in an environment that is challenging, supportive, disciplined, yet, healthy and nurturing.

About the Program

Daily technique classes are offered in ballet, pointe, men's classes, variations and pas de deux. Enrichment, yoga and conditioning classes complete the curriculum. Students are introduced to well-known classical ballets along with contemporary works from the companies repertoire.

Opportunities are provided for advanced level dancers to take company classes and observe the daily rehearsal. The program culminates in *Evening of Dance*, a concert performance with the professional dancers. Students from the summer intensive perform an opening presentation.



Tuition and Placement

Initial class placements are assigned by the student's age and dance experience. Level adjustments will be made if necessary to insure the best learning environment for all students.
